



PICNIC – VELI LOŠINJ – THREE ISLANDS

Excursion by boat

The ship sails from Veli Lošinj towards the Orjule archipelago, where you can take your first bath from the ship. After the picnic that takes place on board, drive to the island of Ilovik.

Ilovik is the southernmost inhabited island in the Lošinj chain, with the fishing village of the same name and 70 inhabitants. The first Croatian settlers came to the island from Veli Lošinj in the 18th century and since then the locality has developed. Holm oak and Aleppo pine mainly grow on the island, but Ilovik is also known as a flower island because oleanders, palm trees, roses and other flowers grow around almost every house. High eucalyptus trees are specific to this island.

In the afternoon the ship runs from the island of Ilovik and goes for a swim in a beautiful bay. In the evening you return to Veli Lošinj.
